General rules and Regulations of the Tournament

- 1. University selection based on tournament performance.
- 2. Separate selection trials will not be conducted.
- 3. FIVB (Federation Internationale de Volleyball) rules apply.
- 4. Each match is best 3 out of 5 sets.
- 5. Set scoring: 25 points (minimum 2-point advantage).
- 6. Third-set tiebreaker: 15 points (minimum 2-point advantage).
- 7. Team roster: 6-12 players.
- 8. Substitutions: unlimited.
- 9. Game duration: 60-90 minutes.
- 10. Time between sets: 5 minutes.
- 11. Warm-up time: 15 minutes before each match.
- 12. Teams must arrive at the tournament venue at least 45 minutes before their scheduled match time.
- 13. Teams must check-in with the tournament staff 30 minutes before their scheduled match time.
- 14. Teams must complete warm-up and preparation 15 minutes before their scheduled match time.
- 15. Teams must be on the court and ready to play at the scheduled match time.

Consequences of Late Reporting

- 1. 1-5 minutes late: Warning
- 2. 6-10 minutes late: Loss of serve or choice of court
- 3. 11-15 minutes late: Forfeit of first set
- 4. 16+ minutes late: Disqualification from tournament
- 5. Team captains are responsible for ensuring their team reports on time.
- 6. Coaches and managers are responsible for ensuring their team is prepared and on time.
